Throughout his life, Reverend Warnock has worked to improve people’s lives by making healthcare affordable and accessible, and ensuring everyone has the right to vote. He’s running for Senate, because he knows right now too many decisions are made in corporate boardrooms and Washington backrooms, not for the people. That’s why he is refusing to accept a dime of corporate PAC money and will always stand up for all Georgians.
